For Dancers: What to expect

Congratulations! You have enrolled in a dance class. The first step to becoming a successful dancer is making a solid commitment to your classes. Hair must be pulled back in a tidy ballet bun, secured with bobby pins and hairspray or a high ponytail. No bangs please.

Dancers are expected to attend all classes with the correct uniform and footwear. Dancewear must be kept clean and tidy and should only be worn for dance class.

For Parents: How will my dancer benefit from joining a dance class at PSOD?

Dance training is life training. All PSOD programs focus on educating young people to strive for their personal best in anything they want to accomplish. In doing so, your dancer will be provided with the opportunity to develop the following skills:

- Gain a sense of balance in life by managing their commitments to both dance and academics.
- Participate in a physical activity that enhances understanding of the value of a healthy body.
- Develop a sense of confidence when speaking or making a presentation in a public setting, which is also a great benefit in university or job interviews.
- Work with mentors who are focused on the students' success inside and outside of the classroom.

I/we agree to release and hold harmless Powell School of Dance Inc., including its teachers, dancers, staff members and facilities used by Powell School of Dance Inc. from any cause of action, claims, or demands now and in the future.

I/we will not hold Powell School of Dance Inc. liable for any personal injury or any personal property damage, which may occur on the premises before, during or after classes. Furthermore, I/we agree to obey the class and facility rules and take full responsibility for my/our behaviour in addition to any damage I/we may cause to the facilities utilized by Powell School of Dance Inc.

By agreeing to this policy, you allow Powell School of Dance Inc. to use your dancer's photo and class choreography for advertising purposes - i.e.: print media, website, social media marketing (Facebook, Twitter, Youtube, Instagram) etc. Please note: No names of dancers will ever be used.

Programming:

To provide a continued level of excellence in dance education to Cornwall & Area, Powell School of Dance Inc. follows graded dance curricula. We are proud to be an accredited dance school with numerous affiliations to reputable dance curricula organizations.

Powell School of Dance Inc. is currently following the *Associated Dance Arts for Professional Teachers* (ADAPT) teaching method for Jazz & Tap; the *Acrobatic Arts* method for Acrodance, and the *Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) & ADAPT Ballet* teaching methods for Classical Ballet.

Class placement:

Class placement is at the full discretion of the PSOD Teaching Faculty. A positive environment and supportive parents are required in the healthy artistic growth of your dancer.

Parking Lot Safety:

Powell School of Dance Inc. is home to children of all ages. Please enter and exit our parking lot with extreme caution. Never park your vehicle in any area that is not a designated parking space. If you park in a space that is very close to the building or its windows, please do not leave your car idling. Please do not allow siblings to play in the parking lot. Please do not block the loading dock door that belongs to our building neighbours. Please do not park on the lawn. Additional parking can be found behind the park and in the old tennis court.

Class Cancellation:

Powell School of Dance Inc. reserves the right to cancel classes due to poor weather/driving conditions, special events, statutory holidays, etc.

Powell School of Dance Inc. will send reminder emails for important dates and special events, as well as cancellations due to poor weather/driving conditions. Please be sure to check your emails regularly.



Inclement Weather Policy:

The safety of all dancers is our #1 priority. As the winter weather approaches, please read below carefully for the official inclement weather policy of Powell School of Dance Inc.

- Powell School of Dance Inc. reserves the right to cancel classes in the event of heavy precipitation, high winds, and dangerous driving conditions.
- Class cancellation is guided by the weather warnings in effect by Environment Canada.
- Class cancellation is guided by the STEO (*Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario*) decisions to remove the school buses from the roads.

If the above conditions are present, Powell School of Dance Inc. will notify parents & dancers by email, phone, and/or social media by 3:00pm on a weekday or 8:00am on the weekend.

Cancelled classes due to inclement weather or extraordinary circumstances will be rescheduled or a make-up class will be provided. A make-up class is already on the schedule and is a class you are invited to attend. A re-scheduled class is a class that is not on the schedule and is therefore offered at an alternate time and day. There are no refunds or credits for class cancellations, re-scheduled classes, or make-up classes. There are no refunds or credits if a student is absent from a make-up class or re-scheduled class.

Peanut, Nut, Seed-Free Environment:

At Ecole de danse Powell School of Dance Inc., your children's safety is our #1 priority. For the safety and consideration of the PSOD community, please be so kind as to respect our Peanut, Nut, and Seed-Free Environment.

Lost and Found:

Please mark all dancewear, shoes, and personal items with your child's name. We will make every effort to locate and return lost items; however, we cannot be responsible for any items that your child brings to class.

Illness:

Colds, flu, and other contagious diseases occur frequently and spread easily among children. To help protect your own child's health and to minimize the possibility of contagion at Powell School of Dance Inc., please keep your child at home if you observe any of the following symptoms:

- Nasal discharge that is green or yellow
- · Complaints of ear pain
- · Consistent cough
- Severe sore throat
- Eyes that are pink, burning, itching, or producing discharge
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- Fever

If these symptoms or other conditions deemed contagious are observed in your child during a class, you will be called to pick up your child immediately.

When your child has a fever, please keep him/her at home until the temperature returns to normal. If there are any lingering signs of illness, such as glassy or watery eyes, listlessness, and drowsiness, please keep your child at home. This will help to ensure that the illness has passed and that your child will be well enough to resume class activities the following week.

Registration Policy:

- Your dancer is automatically re-enrolled for Winter session, unless otherwise specified by November 30.
- Registration for the Fall Session opens on August 21.
- Registration for the Winter session opens on December 1.
- Registration for the Summer Session is separate. Your dancer is not automatically reenrolled.

Fees:

Registration Fee:

- \$33.00 plus HST.
- This is an administrative fee charged to your account one time per session.
- This fee is due on the first day of each session.
- Fall Session: September 5, 2023.
- Winter Session: January 8, 2024.

Tuition Fees:

- \$68 + HST per month.
- Tuition fees for weekly classes are charged on a fixed monthly basis.
- This means that your tuition is the same amount monthly.

Weekly Dancewear Uniform:

For uniformity purposes, dancers are required to purchase all required dancewear items from Powell School of Dance Inc., through the *MyDancewear* landing page.

Costume Fee:

- Price varies: \$100 to \$150 plus HST per costume.
- Powell School of Dance will charge the cost of the costume to your account. When the order is placed, you will be responsible for a 50% deposit on your costume fees. When the order ships to Powell School of Dance, the balance of your costume fees will be due.
- The costumes require being paid in full at the time of delivery to Powell School of Dance Inc.

Rehearsal Fee:

- \$40.00 plus HST per dancer, due June 1, 2024, for the End of Year Rehearsal.
- This is an administrative fee for the location rental and the teacher's time.

- The Rehearsal Fee will be posted to your account at the end of May, will be processed automatically with the credit card on file on the due date.

Recital Fee:

- \$50.00 plus HST per family, due June 1, 2024.
- This is a show production fee for the End-of-Year Recital.
- You will receive the Red, White and Gold Revue digital download by the end of June.
- The Recital Fee will be posted to your account at the end of May and will be processed automatically with the credit card on file on the due date.

Other important fees to note:

- Recital Tickets (May).
- Photo Day Orders (May).
- Babysitter for Show Weekend (June)

Payment Policies

- Ecole de danse Powell School of Dance Inc. accepts payment via credit card (Mastercard and Visa only) on the Online Parent Portal or E-Transfer sent to info@powellschoolofdance.com.
- All payments are subject to the Ontario Harmonized Sales Tax (13% HST).
- Fees for Classes are processed automatically on the 1st of each month.
- There are no refunds or credits on missed classes due to absenteeism or illness.
- Cancelled classes due to inclement weather or extraordinary circumstances will be rescheduled or a make-up class will be provided. A make-up class is already on the schedule and is a class you are invited to attend. A re-scheduled class is a class that is not on the schedule and is therefore offered at an alternate time and day. There are no refunds or credits for class cancellations, re-scheduled classes, or make-up classes. There are no refunds or credits if a student is absent from a make-up class or rescheduled class.
- There is no transfer of fees from one class to another, or one student/sibling to another.
- Official receipts will be provided upon request.
- All accounts must be settled at the end of the annual season (June 9, 2024).
- If a payment declines on the 1st of the month, PSOD will re-attempt payment on the last day of the month.
- Late fees will apply in the amount \$10 per month overdue.
- Declined credit card fees will apply in the amount of \$10 per declined payment.

Transfer/Withdrawal Policy:

- No transfers/withdrawals after the first month of classes has ended (September 30 for the Fall session and January 31 for the Winter session).
- Please understand that your child has made a commitment to a short-term program. Encourage your dancer to continue their commitment through to the end of the Fall session or Winter session. This is an excellent way for your child to learn about commitment, perseverance, and dedication.
- Transfers/Withdrawals that occur between the 1st and 27th of the month will be responsible for 50% of the month's tuition and a \$10 transfer/withdrawal fee.
- Transfer/Withdrawals that occur between the 27th and 31st of the month will be responsible for the upcoming month's payment.
- No refunds for transfers/withdrawals.

Show Weekend Policies:

Babysitter for Show Weekend:

- For the safety and security of your dancer, all dancers require backstage supervision.
- Powell School of Dance requires that all parents provide a babysitter for their dancer backstage.

If you cannot provide a babysitter:

- If you cannot provide a babysitter for your dancer, please volunteer as backstage supervision for the opposite show. A backstage supervisor will then be assigned to your dancer. Example: If your dancer is performing in the Red Revue, please volunteer as backstage supervision for the White Revue or vice versa.

Dancers stay backstage:

 Dancers remain backstage for the entire show. Dancers are not permitted in the audience.
