Programming:

To provide a continued level of excellence in dance education to Cornwall & Area, Powell School of Dance Inc. follows graded dance curricula. We are proud to be an accredited dance school with numerous affiliations to reputable dance curricula organizations.

Powell School of Dance Inc. is currently following the *Associated Dance Arts for Professional Teachers* (ADAPT) teaching method for Jazz & Tap; the *Acrobatic Arts* method for Acrodance, and the *Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) & ADAPT Ballet* teaching methods for Classical Ballet.

Class placement:

Class placement is at the full discretion of the PSOD Teaching Faculty. A positive environment and supportive parents are required in the healthy artistic growth of your dancer.

Parking Lot Safety:

Powell School of Dance Inc. is home to children of all ages. Please enter and exit our parking lot with extreme caution. Never park your vehicle in any area that is not a designated parking space. If you park in a space that is very close to the building or its windows, please do not leave your car idling. Please do not allow siblings to play in the parking lot. Class Cancellation:

Powell School of Dance Inc. reserves the right to cancel classes due to poor weather/driving conditions, special events, statutory holidays, etc.

Powell School of Dance Inc. will send reminder emails for important dates and special events, as well as cancellations due to poor weather/driving conditions. Please be sure to check your emails regularly.

Inclement Weather Policy:

The safety of all dancers is our #1 priority. As the winter weather approaches, please read below carefully for the official inclement weather policy of Powell School of Dance Inc.

- Powell School of Dance Inc. reserves the right to cancel classes in the event of heavy precipitation, high winds, and dangerous driving conditions.
- Class cancellation is guided by the weather warnings in effect by Environment Canada.
- Class cancellation is guided by the STEO (Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario) decisions to remove the school buses from the roads.

If the above conditions are present, Powell School of Dance Inc. will notify parents & dancers by email, phone, and/or social media by 3:00pm on a weekday or 8:00am on the weekend.

Cancelled classes due to inclement weather or extraordinary circumstances will be rescheduled or a make-up class will be provided at no additional cost. A make-up class is an existing class to the schedule and is a class you are invited to attend in place of the cancelled class. A re-scheduled class is a class that is not on the schedule and is therefore offered at an alternate time and day from the cancelled class. There are no refunds or credits for class cancellations, rescheduled classes, or make-up classes. There are no refunds or credits if a student is absent from a make-up class or re-scheduled class.

Lost and Found:

Please mark all dancewear, shoes, and personal items with your child's name. We will make every effort to locate and return lost items; however, we cannot be responsible for any items that your child brings to class.

Illness:

Colds, flu, and other contagious diseases occur frequently and spread easily among children. To help protect your own child's health and to minimize the possibility of contagion at Powell School of Dance Inc., please keep your child at home if you observe any of the following symptoms:

- Nasal discharge that is green or yellow
- Complaints of ear pain
- · Consistent cough
- Severe sore throat
- Eyes that are pink, burning, itching, or producing discharge
- · Diarrhea or vomiting
- Fever

If these symptoms or other conditions deemed contagious are observed in your child during a class, you will be called to pick up your child immediately.

Registration Policy:

- Your dancer is automatically re-enrolled for Winter session, unless otherwise specified by November 30.
- Registration for the Fall Session opens on August 25.
- Registration for the Winter session opens on December 8.
- Registration for the Summer Session is separate. Your dancer is not automatically reenrolled.

Fees:

Please note: Your dancer's fees will be posted to your account for the months of September to December. This will provide you an opportunity to view your fees in full for the Fall Session. If you continue in the Winter Session, the same procedure will be repeated for the Winter Session (January to June).

Registration Fee:

- \$37.00 plus HST.
- This is an administrative fee charged to your account one time per session.
- This fee is due on the first day of each session.
- Fall Session: September 8, 2025.
- Winter Session: January 8, 2026.

Tuition Fees:

- \$74 + HST per month.
- Tuition fees for weekly classes are charged on a fixed monthly basis.
- This means that your tuition is the same amount monthly.

Payment Policies:

- Ecole de danse Powell School of Dance Inc. accepts payment via credit card on the Online Parent Portal.
- All payments are subject to the Ontario Harmonized Sales Tax (13% HST).

- Fees for classes are processed automatically on the 1st of each month.
- There are no refunds or credits on missed classes due to absenteeism or illness.
- Cancelled classes due to inclement weather or extraordinary circumstances will be rescheduled or a make-up class will be provided at no additional cost. A make-up class is an existing class to the schedule and is a class you are invited to attend in place of the cancelled class. A re-scheduled class is a class that is not on the schedule and is therefore offered at an alternate time and day from the cancelled class. There are no refunds or credits for class cancellations, rescheduled classes, or make-up classes. There are no refunds or credits if a student is absent from a make-up class or rescheduled class.
- There is no transfer of fees from one class to another, or one student/sibling to another.
- Official receipts will be provided upon request.
- All accounts must be settled by December 13, 2025, for the Fall Session and June 7, 2026 for the Winter session.

Withdrawal Policy:

Should you withdraw your dancer throughout the Fall or Winter Session, you are still responsible for the tuition fees due in that session.

Example: If you register for the Fall Session in September and wish to withdraw in October, at the time of the withdrawal, you are responsible to pay the balance of fees for October, November, and December tuition fees.

Declined or Failed Payments:

If your payment is declined or fails to process, you will be notified by automated email that your payment did not process. Powell School of Dance will automatically retry the payment up to two (2) additional times within 30 days. If payment is not processed after the third attempt, a \$20 administrative fee will be applied to your account.

Late Payments:

- A 2% monthly interest rate will apply to all late payments after a grace period of 30 days.
- Repeated late payments may require the family to switch to autopay or prepayment plans or may cause an interruption in service.

Questions or Disputes:

If you believe there's been an error or you're experiencing financial difficulty, please contact us as soon as possible. We're happy to work with families on a case-by-case basis.

Acknowledgment:

By enrolling your child at Powell School of Dance Inc., you acknowledge and accept the terms of this policy. It is your responsibility to ensure payment details are current and to notify us of any changes.

Costume Fee:

- Price varies: \$150 to \$200 plus HST per costume.
- Powell School of Dance will charge the cost of the costume to your account. When the order is placed, you will be responsible for a 50% deposit on your costume fees. When the order ships to Powell School of Dance, the balance of your costume fees will be due.
- The costumes require being paid in full at the time of delivery to Powell School of Dance Inc.

Rehearsal Fee:

- \$45.00 plus HST per dancer, due June 1, 2026, for the End of Year Rehearsal.
- This is an administrative fee for the location rental and the teacher's time.
- The Rehearsal Fee will be posted to your account at the end of May, will be processed automatically with the credit card on file on the due date.

Recital Fee:

- \$58.00 plus HST per family, due June 1, 2026.
- This is a show production fee for the End-of-Year Recital.
- You will receive the Red and White Revue digital download by the end of June.
- The Recital Fee will be posted to your account at the end of May and will be processed automatically with the credit card on file on the due date.

Other important fees to note:

- -Photo Day Orders (April)
- -Recital Tickets (May)

Transfer/Withdrawal Policy:

- No transfers/withdrawals after the first month of classes has ended (September 30 for the Fall session and January 31 for the Winter session).
- Please understand that your child has made a commitment to a short-term program. Encourage your dancer to continue their commitment through to the end of the Fall session or Winter session. This is an excellent way for your child to learn about commitment, perseverance, and dedication.
- No refunds for transfers/withdrawals.
- Should you withdraw your dancer throughout the Fall or Winter Session, you are still responsible for the tuition fees due in that session.
- Example: If you register for the Fall Session in September and wish to withdraw in October, at the time of the withdrawal, you are responsible to pay the balance of fees for October, November, and December tuition fees.

Show Policies:

- -Parents are required to find supervision for their dancer during the show.
- -Your dancer remains backstage for the duration of the show. *Please do not purchase a ticket for your dancer.*
